Nehemias hearing the miferable ftate of his countrie men in Iurie, 4. lamenteth, fafteth, and prayeth God for their relief.

The firft part. Nehemias his cõmiferation of his countrie.

he wordes of ^a)Nehemias the fonne of Helchias. And it came to paffe in the moneth of Cafleu, the twenteth yeare, and I was in Sufis the caftel. ² And Hanani one of my brethren came, him felfe and men of Iuda, and I afked them of the Iewes, that remayned, and were left alive of the captivitie, and of Ierufalem. ³ And they fayd to me: They that remayned, and are left of the captivitie there in the prouince, are in great affliction, and in reproche: and the wal of Ierufalem is broken downe, and the gates theref are burnt with fire. ⁴ And when I had heard thefe maner of wordes, I fate, and wept, and mourned many dayes: and fafted, and prayed before the face of the God of heauen. ⁵ And I fayd: I befech thee Lord God of heauen, ftrong, great, and terrible, which keepeft couenant & mercie with them that loue thee, and keepe thy comandmentes: ⁶ let thine eares be harkning, and thine eyes open, to hear the prayer of thy feruant, which I pray before the this day, night & day for the children of Ifrael thy feruantes: and I confeffe for the finnes of the children of Ifrael, in which they have finned to thee: I & my fathers houfe haue finned, ⁷ we haue bene feduced with vanitie, and have not kept thy commandments, and cerimonies and iudgement, which thou haft commanded to Moyfes thy feruant. ⁸ Remember the word, that thou didft command vnto Moyfes thy feruant, faying: When you fhal tranfgreffe, I will depreffe you into

peoples: ⁹ and if you returne to me, and keepe my precepts, and doe them, although you fhal be led away to the vttermoft partes of heauen, thence wil I gather you, and bring you backe into the place, which I haue chofen that my name fhould dwel there. ¹⁰ And they are thy feruantes, and thy people: whom thou haft redemed in thy great ftrength, and in thy mighty hand. ¹¹ I befech thee Lord, let thine eare be attent to the prayer of thy feruant, and to the prayer of thy feruants, which will feare thy name: and direct thy feruant this day, and giue him mercy before this man, for I was the kings cupbearer.
